Neithercut remarks featured in recent *Crain's Detroit Business*

Mark Neithercut, principal of Neithercut Advisors LLC and a member of the NNCG Steering Committee, offers his perspectives on two timely philanthropic topics in the November 10, 2008 issue of *Crain's Detroit Business*.

Neithercut's column, “Loosen your strings on charitable giving,” encourages donors and foundations to resist the trend toward restricting giving, especially during this economic downturn. The column cites challenges faced by many nonprofits that have well-funded programs, but no money for core administrative expenses, such as utilities and insurance.

Neithercut is also quoted in the *Crain's Detroit Business* article, “Family foundations on rise; creating a legacy among the benefits.” He offers caveats on the increasing tendency of wealthy families to establish foundations as a charitable vehicle of choice.
